







- \* Please use the supporting tools when installing. It is better for installation by 2 people. Please be careful.




## STEP 1. ATTACH MOUNT TO WORK SURFACE

For installation on open edge

of work surface:

Slide the Base Stem(A)against work surface edge and fully tighten clamp Screw(B).




#### STEP 2. ATTACH ARM TO BASE STEM

 Insert the rear arm into the Base Stem, tighten the screw(A) by Hex Key.

b. Insert the Forearm into the top of rear arm, tighten the screw

(B) by Hex Key.




#### STEP 3. ATTACH VESA CONNECTOR TO MONITOR

Place VESA connector in position on back of monitor with clips (A) on the left and right. Attach using 4 Standard VESA connector Screws provided. VESA connector can accommodate 75mm and 100mm hole patterns. For this installation, you may also use screws that came with your monitor.





The VESA connector will be placed on the bottom of foam.



### STEP 4. ATTACH MONITOR TO ARM

Cock Quick-Release
Tab(A),slide the VESA
connectorof monitor into the
arm bracket(B) ,punch the
Quick-Release Tab(A) until it
clicks.






Note: To Remove, please cock Quick-Release Tab(A) again and slide device up and away from arm.



#### STEP 5. CABLE MANAGEMENT

a. Route power and monitor cables through the cable clips on the upper links.

 b. Slide the plastic cover on the lower link upward until it disengages, then remove (A). Position power and monitor cables onto the plastic cover inside(B), and slide the cover downward until it clicks into place(C).




#### STEP 6. ARM ADJUSTMENTS

# a. Friction Adjustment


If you feel the pitching angle too tight or too loose when adjusting the mount, please adjust the Screw (A).

If you feel the horizontal angle too tight or too loose when adjusting the mount, please adjust the Screw (B).



# b. Weight Adjustment

The load weight of mount is 1.5to9kg, factory default settings:3to4kg, it will decreases gradually when adjusting the Screw(C) by clockwise rotation, vice versa.





Note: Once you feel the damping of screw increases or cannot be rotated, please stop avoid of damaging the mount.
